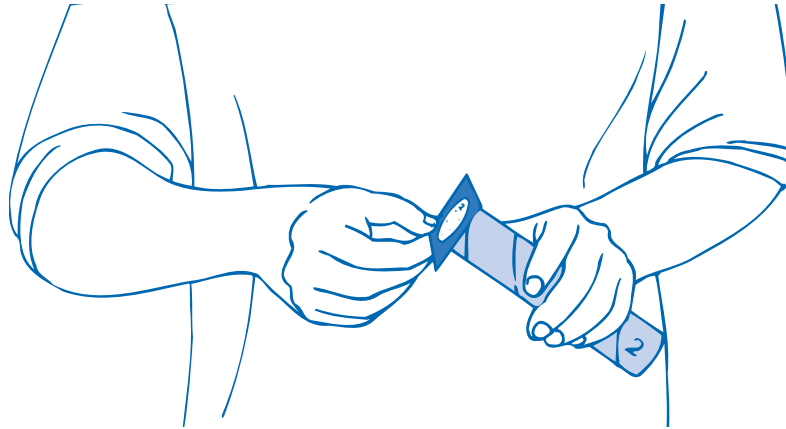
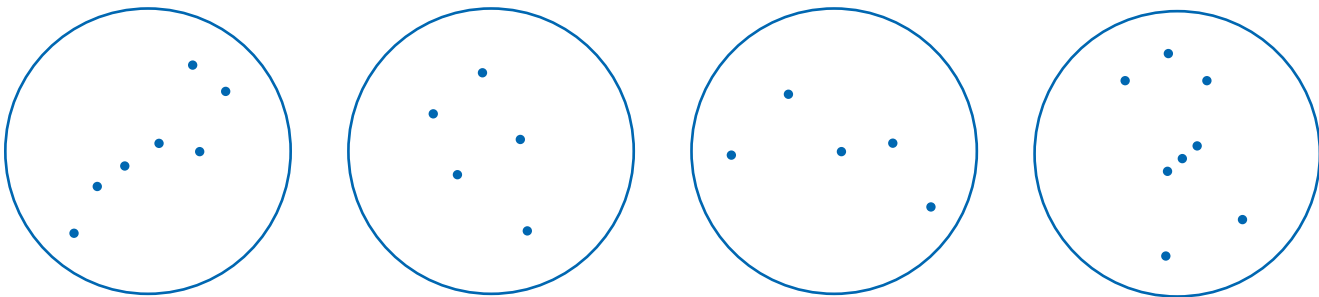


Constellations: Stories in the Sky

1. Make your constellation viewer: Use a pattern and a push pin to make a constellation. Glue the square of black paper over one end of the tube and let the glue dry. Locate the number on the pattern. Write this number on the tube.



2. Point your constellation tube toward a light source and look through the tube. Match the pattern you see with one of the patterns below. Write the tube number under the pattern that matches it. Then write the name of the constellation beside the number.



3. Swap viewers with a team whose viewer has a different number. View the constellation inside. Record the number and name of the constellation you see under its pattern above.
4. Swap viewers two more times until you have viewed all four constellations. Record the number and name of each constellation under its pattern above.
