



**Recall Notice on Horseshoe Magnets:**

**3” Steel Horseshoe Magnet (Delta part number 130-2971)**

**6” Steel Horseshoe Magnet (Delta part number 130-0254)**



Dear Delta Education Customer:

United Scientific has supplied Delta Education and numerous other educational companies with steel horseshoe magnets that are now part of a voluntary recall. The surface coating applied to these horseshoe magnets was tested and determined to contain amounts of lead in excess of those permitted by the regulations issued by the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC).

Delta Education, which is always concerned with student safety, has asked us to notify you directly about this recall. Delta has also provided a UPS billing number so you can send your magnets to United Scientific at no cost to you. Upon receipt of your magnets, United Scientific will send you safe replacements, naturally at no charge.

Although this is a voluntary recall, Delta Education and United Scientific strongly encourage you to remove the horseshoe magnets from your classrooms. Please take advantage of this recall and replacement offer described in more detail below.

1) For proper disposal of the horseshoe magnets, please return them to United Scientific to the following address. (Be sure to send your magnets to United Scientific, not to Delta.)

2) Please fill out the return form and include it in your package, telling us where to send the replacements.

3) For your convenience, you can return the magnets via UPS using the third-party billing option. Simply check the “Bill Third Party” section and fill in the following UPS account number: 255-7E2.

4) Once United Scientific receives your magnets, we will dispose of them properly and send you new product that has been tested and certified safe by the EMSL Analytical Labs in Chicago, IL.

When you order in the future, you can rest assured that Delta Education will provide you with safe steel horseshoe magnets that have been tested and approved. You'll know these magnets are safe because they'll have a "U" stamped on them. Delta Education will continue to implement its product safety plan, which includes product reviews by reliable third-party testing facilities.
